How To Make A Reindeer card!

Paper Scar


To start let's grab a piece of brown paper and a pencil.

Place your hand flat on the paper and draw around it.

Next, carefully cut out the hand shape you just drew!



Now pick a different coloured paper and cut out 2 antier shapes, 4 hooves and a small tail too! Next take your cut out hand and turn it upside down. Now glue on the cut out shapes. Look at the picture to see where they go! E.g: Antlers on the base of the thumb and hooves at the finger tips. Step 6: take a red sticker or cut out a small circle for the reindeers nose! Stick this at the end of the thumb and draw on the eyes!



Step 7: Take an A5 piece of paper and fold it in half to make a card. You could write any Christmas Messege you like in here!



Step 8: Let's add a background! Could you draw some snow or cut out some tree shapes? Lastly at Step 9 it's time to stick your reindeer onto the card!

This craft is inspired by exhibiting artist Abigail Reynolds whose work embraces her passion for books and libraries.

Reynolds sees libraries as safe place where books are 'handled and handed' down over and over again. Reynolds work includes imagery of hands and colourful, overlapping shapes.
